**Eligibility:**

- Flu shot: Anyone 6 months and older.
- COVID-19 vaccine: individuals born in 2009 or earlier for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> doses.
- 3<sup>rd</sup>/ booster doses are available for the following if at least six months have passed since the last dose:
  - Individuals born in 1951 or earlier
  - Individuals who received two doses of the AstraZeneca vaccine or one dose of the Janssen vaccine
  - First Nation, Inuit or Métis adult and their non-Indigenous household members
  - Health care workers and designated essential caregivers in congregate settings (including long-term care home and retirement home staff and designated caregivers)



**Walk-ins only while supplies last.**



**Starting November 10, every Wednesday and Thursday for the remainder of 2021.**

\*Thursday clinics are in the multi-purpose room on the first floor.
